The Main Tasks of CSO Structures

1. The Technical Office

The Technical Office consists of (13) directorates responsible for the tasks below:

1.1 Agricultural Statistics Directorate

Agricultural Statistics Directorate implements periodical surveys to estimate the cultivated area, yield average & the production of all agricultural crops, takes into consideration seasonal & geographical distribution and irrigation means by the implementing entity. As well as, it estimates the orchards area, trees number and production by fruit kinds, livestock number and production, fishing and agricultural machinery, it also calculates the field prices of agricultural & livestock products, defines water resources, livestock & chicken gardens indicators. It conducted the 2001 comprehensive agricultural census, which is frequently conducted, according to international recommendations, every 10 years.

1.2 Industrial Statistics Directorate

Industrial Statistics Directorate annually provides industrial activity data that cover large, intermediate and small industrial establishments. The directorate conducts quarterly surveys about large & intermediate establishments, periodical surveys, beside; it provides information about electricity and water sectors. Through these surveys and other statistics activities, it can define indicators about product value, quantity and requirements, capital, employee's numbers & wages and economical & financial indicators.

1.3 Building & Construction Statistics Directorate

Building & Construction Statistics Directorate provides statistical information about building & construction activity in Iraq through conducting periodical statistics below:

- Public sector buildings & construction statistics.
- Public sector contracts, buildings & construction.
- Buildings & reconstruction licenses given to private sector.
- Private sector buildings statistics.
- Private sector construction materials prices statistics.

Through these statistics the directorate can identify indicators i.e. employees numbers & wages by skill, construction materials value & quantity used in building, numbers of buildings, constructions & projects really implemented by one year according to economical sectors and other base indicators. It also conducts periodical surveys of construction & building sector activity.

1.4 Trade Statistics Directorate

Trade Statistics Directorate provides statistical information about the external, internal and tourism trade. As for external trade the directorate collects and classifies exports, imports & transits data according to tariff statement provided by state commission for costumes according to custom regions in Iraq. Classified statistics reports are prepared & issued according to international recommendations. Regarding for the internal trade, the directorate concentrate on four fields, they are:

- Hotels & tour lodging houses sector.
- Internal trade of public sector.
- Internal trade of private sector.
- Internal trade of cooperative sector (cooperative consuming associations).

Annual data about (public & co-operative sectors) are being annually collected, beside periodical surveys conducted regarding the private sector. The directorate provides annual data related to hotels and tour accommodation.

1.5 Transportation & Communication Directorate

Transportation & Communication Directorate provides statistical data of land, air and marine transportation activity for (messengers & goods), beside it provides information about cars numbers & features in (public, mixed, private) sectors and information about operative charge of productive cars, communication & posting activities, internet cafes as well as annual comprehensive & detailed statistical data of traffic accidents recorded in police offices. It implements surveys of land transportation and information & communication technology activities.

1.6 Educational & social statistics Directorate

Educational & social statistics directorate provides periodical educational & social statistical information covering health, social care & reformation), educational statistics of (kindergarten to advanced studies), academic & professional education, teachers preparing, parallel education and developed professional training in Iraq.

It conducts various surveys of personal & public services i.e. works, libraries, medical labs,...etc, and specified surveys using preview method i.e. Multi Indicators Cluster Survey (MICS), parents care behaviors survey and nonsystematic education survey .Also it supervises the mother & child unit works which collects & analyses mother & child data indicators.

1.7 Population & labor statistics Directorate

Population & Labor statistics Directorate implements population censuses to make out comprehensive & detailed statistical indicators of population, social, economical & housing changes by smallest administrative unit (urban/rural).As well as it provides statistical frameworks of all economical activities to be used in specialized surveys.

It implements demographical surveys using previewing method i.e. living aspects Survey, Fertility Survey & Immigration Survey. It analyzes surveys & census results and set population lays out between censuses, also for long times. In labor statistics context, the directorate implement annual household survey of employment and unemployment to make out indicators about unemployment rate, economical activity, underemployment for certain age by governorates.

1.8 National Accounts

This directorate accounts and estimates economic indicators at national level as follow:

- Provisional and final estimates for domestic product & national income.
- Provisional and final estimates for gross fixed capital formation.
- Commodity activities.
- Indicators of financial analysis for public, mixed and private sector as bellow:
 - Mixed sector.
 - Manufacturing Industry (public sector).
 - Banks & insurance (public and private sector).
 - Trade (public sector).
 - Oil extraction and mining.
 - Electricity and water.
 - Industry overlapping tables.
 - User table.
 - Estimate monthly economic indicator.

1.9 Directorate of Living Condition Statistics

It conducts essential and important statistical surveys which provide social and economic indicators on household in Iraq such as households' expenditure on one hand and income on the another, health, education, work, residence condition, activity & hobby and time use by household. Beside, indicators on loans & assistances which household gained and negative effects that influence on household's income & expenditure and household ownership of perennial commodities. These indicators used to evaluate living condition of household in Iraq by using expenditure indicators in measuring poverty through a study to evaluate poverty.

1.10 **Directorate of Environmental Statistics**

This directorate provides environmental statistical data in collaboration with other relevant to environmental aspect or carries out surveys. These data help decision-makers, planners and researchers.

Work plan for 2012 is:

1. Issued environmental statistics report/2011 which exposes data that will gather from related.
2. Working on implementing environmental pollutants for industrial sector in Iraq survey.
3. Updating perpetual development report.
4. Environmental accounting.

1.11 **Index Numbers Directorate**

Issued monthly and annual reports for index numbers of consumer price this would help in measuring inflation, exports & imports indices, industry, agriculture and building and housing indices. Updating accounted indices rules & composing new indices as required for accounting national accounts indicators & other sections.

It also the Directorate responsibility for implementation of ICP surveys carried out in collaboration with the ESCWA Organization.

1.12 **Directorate of Human Development Statistics**

Within new structure of CSO had updated this directorate to take into account collect data and development indicators for different sectors (education, health ...etc.) as available of this data from relevant directorates and ministries. Preparing indicators in the

manner of reliable reports regionally and internationally, a report to observe development in millennium development goals aspect & adept these goals nationally and update it periodically, while ensuring international & regional comparability with similar data.

Issued gender statistics report in Iraq by gender statistics unit which formed in Iraq in collaboration with (ESCWA), (UNDP), (UNIFEM), and set up a data base for gender by using (Dev-info) programme that published on new website (www.cosit_igu.org.iq).

Also data analysis with high quality reliance and buildup data quality & indicators to ensure international compare. A new unit had formed within this directorate “food security unit” for monitoring & evaluating household nutrition in Iraq through conducting food security surveys. During (2003, 2005 and 2007) three surveys had been conducted in collaboration with Ministry of Health (nutrition searches institute) and world foods programme (WFP) and issued report “monitor and evaluate food aids distribution on displaced households in Iraq”.

1.13 **Statistical Analysis Unit**

Providing comprehensive and accurate data as manual for planner since it exposes reality of society in past, present & helps in drawing plans in future. Thus this unit collects & prepares indicators on data and statistics of technical directorates.

2. Information Technology

Includes (6) directorates as below:

2.1 Systems and Programs Directorate

Runs & updates systems and programs of the annual plan, Prepares new annual, quarterly & monthly systems & programs of CSO's departments, sets guidelines of operating and follows up the conducting process until final reports are issued, Develops staff qualities by involving in surveys and training courses in and outside Iraq.

2.2 Systems Engineering Directorate

Provides programs, soft and hard ware installation and maintenance service, design, install and manage of net works (internal nets & internet) according to international standards, provides center of training and statistical researches with lecturers on computers courses.

2.3 Computer Operations Directorate

Conducts questionnaires data entry of systems applied in CSO, corrects entry defects, collects files of each system, runs the systems, issues & prints reports.

2.4 Database Directorate

Provides Information Bank (e- data base) about employees in state ministries & NGOs and annually updates data to be used in labor force planning to serve Iraq economy. Provides data on number of employees, distribution by occupation, scientific specialization, marital status & educational attainment. Designs &

carries out systems by using CSPRO & ORACLE and it is in charge of CSO website on internet.

2.5 Nets & Maintenance Directorate

Maintains computers & accessories & installs internal nets in CSO departments.

3. Financial & Administrative department

3.1 Administration Directorate

Provides administrative services for CSO's departments and staff manage financial and account affairs in CSO and governorates statistics departments. Follows up investment plan performance concerning with buildings purchasing, construction, and renovation in Baghdad & governorates as well as building capacities for administrative staff.

Work plan of Financial & Administrative department (investment plan) is:

- Purchasing real estates in some districts.
- Building statistic divisions in some districts.
- Renovation, construction and adding new building for CSO departments in governorates.
- Conducting capacity building program for CSO administrative staff.

3.2 Human Resources Directorate

Responsible of salaries, wages, promotions, premiums, bonuses & praise letters as well as procedures of accounting service years. It follows up delegations arrangements, training courses, abroad scholarship and temporary contractors systems on IT, prepares plans concerning with conducting training courses for

employees working in administrative affairs in Baghdad and other governorates in and outside Iraq.

3.3 Accounts Directorate

- Prepares the current and investment budget and monthly balances which are sent to the Ministry of Finance.
- Distributes the monthly salaries, premiums and benefits to the employees and contractors as well as follows up expending on investment projects.
- Prepares mechanism of expenditure of household social and economic survey in Iraq.

3.4 Publishing and relations Directorate

Prepares and issues the annual statistical abstract and Iraq Figures and Indicators booklet, release annual, quarterly and monthly activities and achievements reports of CSO directorates, the monthly guide of CSO publications or any other bulletin released by the directorate. It provides various State institutions, agencies, Arab international organizations, researchers, high studies and school students with statistical data and information. It disseminates statistical information through media to enhance the statistical awareness.

In addition, it prepares and manages the logistic media and service matters regarding to workshops, seminars, sessions, meetings and conferences, celebrations of releasing statistical surveys results in and outside CSO. It follows up the CSO annual action plan and prepares reports about achievements levels beside it coordinates with Arab, regional and international organizations as well as companies and institutions of public and mixed sectors. It disseminates news and activities on CSO website and observes Arab and foreign websites to

convey the developed dissemination process in the world.

3.5 Printing Office Directorate

Prints all publications, releases, monthly reports, questionnaires for surveys, the weekly newspaper, the monthly magazine, posters, registries, folders and all other statistical data and information publications of ministry of planning and CSO.

The directorate includes the following divisions:

1. Printing
2. Computer to Plate (CTP)
3. Designing
4. Post Press

4. Divisions associated with the CSO Head Office.

4.1 Training and Statistical Research Centre

Since the training process has a significant importance, the Training and Statistical Research Centre aims to create, develop and support employees' capacities and skills working either in state or mixed sectors.

4.2 Auditing department

It checks the accounting transactions orders prepared by Accounts Directorate to be sure that the orders are legally follow the financial instructions and regulations before they have been cashed.

- Conducts the annual stocktaking and matches the quarterly stocktaking tables with the book ones, follows-up the work in the storage and conduct a surprise check up visit to storage assets.
- Inspection visits to the governorates.

- Presents periodic reports to the director.

4.3 **Legal department**

Studies all the issues received from the CSO directorates (centre and governorates) and provide legal consultations to be implemented according to the laws and instructions in force. It represents CSO to courts and justice institutes as well as official and unofficial agencies. It prepares all tenders, projects and contracts CSO involved in according to investment plan and Census activities.

4.4 **Engineering Division**

Follows up CSO buildings in Baghdad and governorates as follow:

- ❖ Statistics directorates buildings in Umarah governorate.
- ❖ Training Centre buildings renovation in Najaf governorate.
- ❖ Tel-Afar Statistics division buildings.
- ❖ AL-Hadar Statistics division buildings.
- ❖ AL-Faloja Statistics division buildings.
- ❖ AL-Numania Statistics division buildings.
- ❖ Receiving Haditha Statistics division building.
- ❖ Receiving Ministry of Planning Buildings in Basrah.
- ❖ Purchasing lands in districts.
- ❖ Rehabilitation of statistics directorate building in AL-Muthanna.
- ❖ Rehabilitation of statistics directorate building in Wasit.

5. Executive management of poverty reduction strategy

The management was formed pursuant to the resolution of Council of Ministers No.409 of 2009 aiming at adopting a mechanism to insure the implementation, monitoring and assessment of activities and programs of poverty reduction strategy. In coordination with ministries and governorates, the directorate determines the priorities of activities mentioned in the strategy to be included in their programs and plans, monitors the implementation of strategy activities, supervise programs of monitoring and assessment, issues reports on strategy implementation with concentration on obstacles that hamper work progress, conducts statistical surveys and studies and cooperate with organizations and donor states for technical and financial assistance to implement some of the strategy activities.

5. Surveys to be implemented during 2012

6.1 Population and Housing Census

The census aims to obtain updated and accurate data on all individuals in specific period of time and the different characteristics of buildings, houses and households in Iraq. These data are considered to be the corner stone to measure the change by time as well as to prepare the developmental plans and assess their findings. These data represent tools necessary for preparing population and housing policies, development plans and other economic, health programs.....etc.,.

Despite Population and Housing Census is carried out once every ten years and the last census has been implemented since 1997 excluding the governorates of Kurdistan region, thus there was lack of real data due to the demographic changes after the war and the new circumstances the war resulted in like moving between governorates (internal migration) or citizens return from abroad (international migration) to be settled and adapt to the new situation and the structure changes occurred in the economy and society, thus it is needed to provide new digital indicators to meet the expected need to insure building the democratic institutions to prepare economic and social policies by implementing population census to provide detailed data to conduct elections and build political institutions on digital, informative and reliable bases ,for this reason the preparations for Population and Housing Census has been started since 2003.

6.2 Employment and Unemployment Survey

This survey is conducted by sample for four stages which include issue report in details for each stage. It is include data about unemployment rates for (15 +) year, youth unemployment, incomplete employment & economic activity rates.

6.3 labor Market Survey

MoP/ human development directorate conducting the above mentioned survey in collaboration with third-party. This survey conducted by sample of households and its may completion during 2012.

6.4 Iraq Household Socio- Economic Survey (IHSES2)

Living condition directorate will conduct in 2012 the above mentioned survey and will continue for one year (calendar). The sample size will be (25488) households distributed on Iraq governorates. It aims to providing data help in measuring, poverty analysis, monitoring conduct National poverty reduction strategy that issued in 2009, integrated system of data to estimate socio-economic situation for household, indicators that relevant with human development, providing data which meet needs of national accounts, providing indicators regarding consumer expenditure and its influence with changes which may help decision- make that concern production, consumer, import & export, providing indicators regarding inter individuals & households by resources and providing data to form new index number for consumer prize for after 2012.

6.5 Environmental pollutions survey of industrial sector in Iraq

Central Statistical Organization / Environment Statistics Directorate will conduct environmental pollutions survey of industrial sector in Iraq to provide database on the quality and quantity of the industrial pollutions given off by factories and various establishments, means of controlling these pollutions, number and quantity of pollution treatment units (if available), methods of pollution disposal and quality and quantity of waste.

6.6 Tools, Machinery and Equipments Survey

Building and construction sector is considered to be one of the most important sectors as it contributes to produce the infrastructures necessary for economic development. It also has an important role in the statistics of economic activities where it provides key indicators to estimate gross national product and capital accounts to implement construction projects identify tools, machinery and equipments needed to implement these projects in construction and development and reconstruction as well as reducing projects costs. The directorate conducted first tools, machinery and equipment survey in 2003 by which all ministries, non-governmental state agencies, private sector contractors and hiring offices in the governorates and the cost of hiring and purchasing for the purposes of national accounts and to estimate the need to provide these equipments for building, construction and policy-making for the construction sector.

Field work phase has been completed on 25/12/2010 in 15 governorates for public sector(ministries and non-governmental agencies) and private sector(tools, machinery and equipments hiring office, construction companies and contractor) list of contractors,

classification and specialization (depending on contractors framework in the legal department at ministry of planning and the framework available at Building and construction Directorate) and initial report have been prepared to prepare final report.

To adopt inclusiveness in survey indicators, CSO approached KRSO to contribute to the implementation of survey. It has been implemented during October and December 2011 in Kurdistan Region (Erbil, Dohouk and Sulaimaniyah) by adopting contractor's framework of contractors union in the region as well as CSO framework. Questionnaires are audited and coded to be integrated into the indicators of Iraq governorates to issue the comprehensive and final report.

6.7 Project of Statistical System Development and reform in Iraq

In the frame of cooperation with UN organizations, CSO in coordination with UNFPA implements the project of the statistical system development and reform in Iraq over three years as of April/2012 to 2014. The project is considered to be one of the UN projects aiming at reforming and developing public sector in Iraq (education, health, water and sanitation) as an activity intersecting with these sectors where development cannot be achieved without an effective statistical system.

To increase the awareness of officials in the ministries, it was decided to organize a statistical conference during January 2012 to discuss and analyze the statistical reality in the ministries and non-governmental agencies and discuss the plans of ministries specialized in the statistical work.

Trough the project, the legal and legislative frame supporting statistical work was discussed by reviewing the statistics act and adding some notes related to the inclusion of the official statistics guidelines issued by United Nations.
